

## Spring Themed Trips At Bellaboo's

### *Manners for Me*



This hands-on, do-it-yourself trip about manners introduces basic etiquette concepts in an intriguing, playful and (most-importantly) encouraging fashion. "Manners for Me" focuses on not just knowing the right way to do something, but wanting to do something the right way out of respect for yourself and others. Children will enjoy tea time as they create their own Petit Four. We will glide gracefully through some physically activities which will teach them how to set a proper table, do the basic box step and entering a room with confidence. Book a Manners for Me trip and help your children experience a social delight. Minimum of 15 students/Maximum of 125 students.

### **Ecology**



How we care for the earth today will have a big impact on the world tomorrow. Our field trip on ecology will teach your students about the natural world around them and the living things in relation to the biosphere they inhabit. It is about preservation and conservation of our planet. All living things are linked in what we call our habitat. Children will learn how they can pitch in to save the earth. We will explore the 3 R's -Recycle, Reuse, and Reduce and participate in a recycling-trash sorting race. The children will create their own edible compost pile in the Interactive Kitchen. In addition, your students will learn how to preserve and protect our natural resources- like the local dunes and Lake Michigan.

**DINOSAUR**- Dinosaurs fascinate children. Dinosaurs are the most interesting way to spark a child's interest and concern for preservation. Through dinosaurs, children will look at diet and the environment as it relates to extinction. During your educational field trip, your students will be hands-on excavating their own dinosaur dig. Acting as young paleontologists, your students will try to re-assemble the "fossils" they find to make a dinosaur skeleton. Our young visitors will also explore the meaning of extinction. We will discuss and share ways in which we can help preserve and protect our endangered species.
